Ramsey Heights Countryside Classroom

is located off Chapel Road in Ramsey Heights village, close to Ramsey (postcode PE26 2RS). The turn into the road is signposted by a brown sign (Woodwalton Fen and Countryside Classroom). There is also a red house on the corner.

There is a bus service from Peterborough, Ramsey and villages in between, which stops at the bottom of Chapel Road (about half a mile's walk from the classroom). **Please visit www.traveline.org.uk or call 0871 200 22 33 for details.**

Free Parking. A signposted parking area is provided approximately 80 metres from the building. Parking 30 metres from the building is also available for blue badge holders and permit holders. From both parking areas there is surfaced path with a slope of 1 in 20 to the building.
