

## **Directions to Ramsey Heights Nature Reserve (please also see map on page 4)**

**Postcode for Satellite Navigation - PE26 2RS (Chapel Road)**

### **By public transport:**

Public transport to Ramsey Heights Nature Reserve and Woodwalton Fen National Nature Reserve is limited. For up to date options near you, visit [www.traveline.org.uk](http://www.traveline.org.uk) or call 0871 200 22 33.

### **By road:**

#### **From A14 westbound**

- Exit the A14 at junction 23 for Huntingdon (Spittals Interchange).
- At the exit roundabout, turn right to Huntingdon Industrial Areas and A141 to March.
- Go straight over the next 3 roundabouts (still following the A141 to March).
- Shortly after the 3<sup>rd</sup> roundabout, turn left for Kings Ripton and the Kart Track.
- From Kings Ripton, follow signs to Little Raveley, Great Raveley and Upwood.
- Do not turn off into Upwood village or at the brown sign for the nature reserve (this is for Upwood Meadows). Continue straight ahead until you reach a left turn signed Peterborough, Ramsey Heights and the gliding club – turn here.
- Continue to Ramsey Heights, then take the left turn (Chapel Road) signed to Ramsey Heights Countryside Classroom and Woodwalton Fen (red house on the corner).
- Chapel Road becomes a fairly rough track. After half a mile, you will see the Trust's Ramsey Heights Countryside Classroom and car park on the right.

#### **From A1 southbound and northbound; A14 eastbound**

- For A14 eastbound, join A1 northbound at junction 21 (Brampton Hut)
- Exit A1 at junction 15 for Sawtry. (Although this is a longer route for A1 northbound, it is much simpler to continue to junction 15 rather than to exit at junction 14)
- Take B1043 southbound towards Woodwalton and Abbots Ripton (NB Woodwalton Fen is not at the village of Woodwalton).
- Follow signs to Woodwalton, then to Great Raveley and then to Upwood.
- Do not turn off into Upwood village or at the brown sign for the nature reserve (this is for Upwood Meadows). Continue straight ahead until you reach a left turn signed Peterborough, Ramsey Heights and the gliding club – turn here.
- Continue to Ramsey Heights, then take the left turn (Chapel Road) signed to Ramsey Heights Countryside Classroom and Woodwalton Fen (red house on the corner).
- Chapel Road becomes a fairly rough track. After half a mile, you will see Trust's Ramsey Heights Countryside Classroom and car park on the right.

### **From Peterborough**

- From the Fletton parkway (A1139), take the exit to Yaxley and the A15 (The Serpentine)
- Go straight over the first roundabout, then take the second exit at the second roundabout, turning onto the A15 (London Road).
- Continue into and through Yaxley
- Turn left onto the B1091 (Broadway) at the last set of traffic lights (BP petrol station just back from corner), and then **immediately** right (Dovecote Lane)
- At the end of Dovecote Lane, bear left onto Church Street.
- At the end of Church Street, turn right onto Main Street, and **immediately** left onto Hod Fen Drove.
- Follow Hod Fen Drove all the way to the T junction in Holme.
- Turn left at the T junction onto the B660, Long Drove.
- Cross over the level crossing, then follow the B660 all the way to the T junction in Ramsey St Marys (Long Drove becomes Holme Road).
- Turn right at the T junction, onto the B1040 (Herne Road).
- Continue straight ahead to Ramsey Heights (do not take the left turn to Ramsey).
- Chapel Road becomes a fairly rough track. After half a mile, you will see Trust's Ramsey Heights Countryside Classroom and car park on the right.

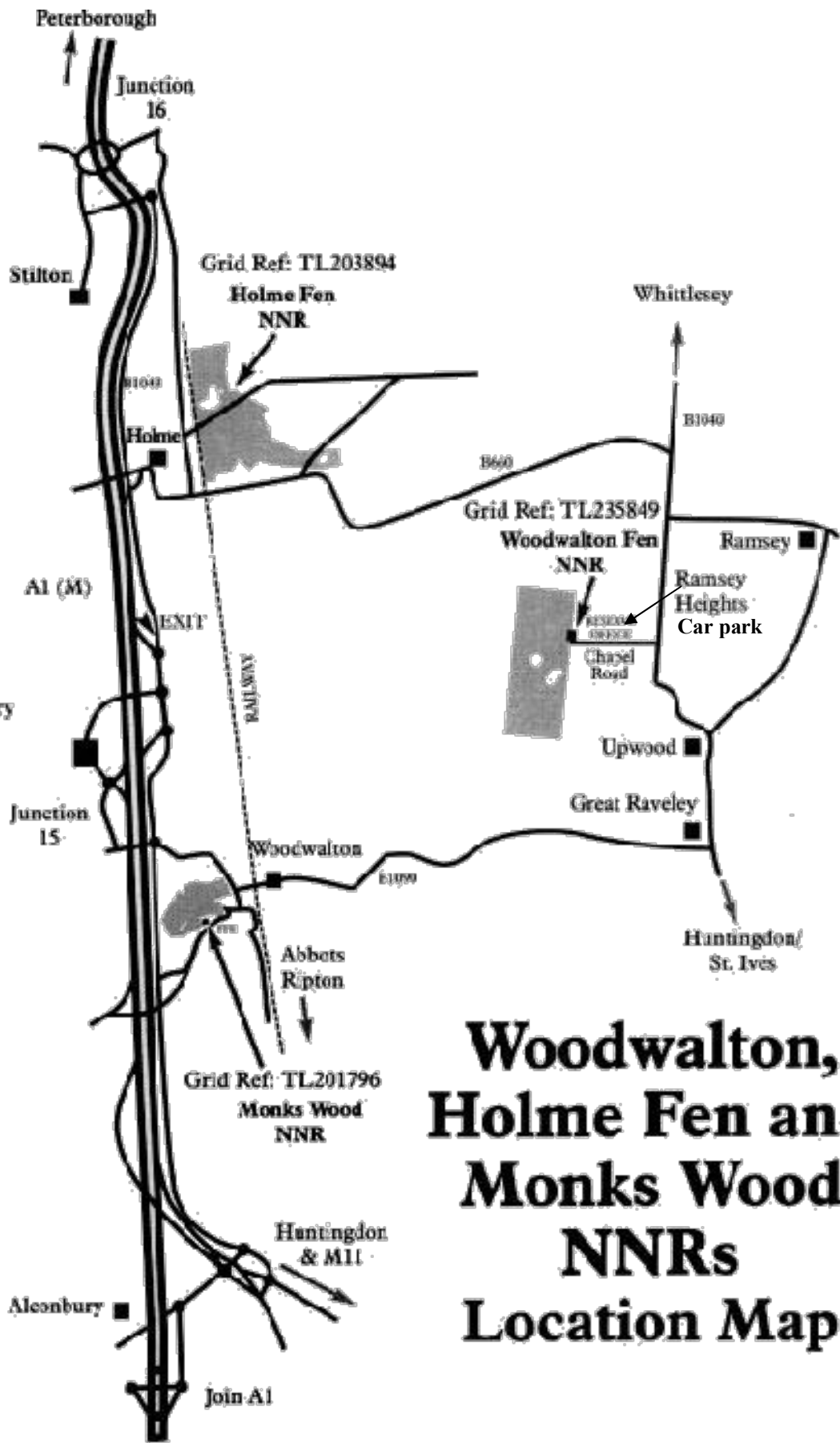
